JUDGING RUBRIC

Scoring Methodology

Scores 1 – 5

1 = Unsatisfactory answer and proposal should not be funded unless further explanation is provided.

2 = Fair, this component of the proposal has associated risks.

3 = Reasonable, this component of the proposal meets the requirements of the specific key selection criteria.

4 = Good, this component of the proposal is good and it more than meets the specific key selection criteria.

5 = Excellent, this component of the proposal is excellent.

Judging Table

Scores are allocated according to the Scoring Methodology for each element of the proposal according to the Key Selection Criteria.

Key Selection Criteria	Score 1 – 5
<p>Project idea – What is your idea?</p> <p><i>Overall concept of the project.</i></p>	
<p>What value does your idea bring to your group or the wider community?</p> <p><i>Perceived community value.</i></p>	
<p>What is the name of the local certified forest that you want to access, support, improve or promote?</p> <p><i>Connectedness to a Responsible Wood certified forest or chain of custody certificate holder.</i></p>	
<p>Has the local Responsible Wood certified forest grower or Chain of Custody producer supported this project? If so, please describe their support.</p> <p><i>Level of endorsement from a Responsible Wood certified forest or chain of custody certificate holder.</i></p>	
<p>Why do you want to undertake this project?</p> <p><i>Project purpose and impact.</i></p>	
<p>Are you able to complete your project by June 30th, 2025?</p> <p><i>Project feasibility.</i></p>	
<p>Is your project likely to develop any Intellectual property or products?</p> <p><i>Novelty of the idea.</i></p>	
<p>How will you promote the project to your community and beyond?</p> <p><i>Responsible Wood Certification Scheme promotion through the project (i.e. signage, media, case studies).</i></p>	
<p>Budget – Please list all budget items for the project.</p> <p><i>Project planning and methodology.</i></p>	

<p>Are you working with any other community groups to deliver this project? If so, please describe.</p> <p><i>Project impact through collaboration.</i></p>
